Summary Methodology • Analytical framework, concepts, definitions and classifications • Scope of the data • Compilation practices	Service Production Index (SPI) is a composite indicator which is compiled on a monthly basis (base year 2022) and presented in term of constant price in order to measure short-term movement of services industries. There are 33 components from 12 service activities to be calculated as the SPI by applying the fix-base Laspeyres method. Each components of SPI is assigned weight by its value-added attributed to GDP in services activities in 2022. The main service activities classified according to ISIC Rev.4 consist of (1) Construction (2) Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (3) Transportation and storage (4) Accommodation and food service activities (5) Information and communication (6) Financial and insurance activities (7) Real estate activities (8) Professional, scientific and technical activities (9) Administrative and support service activities (10) Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (11) Education and (12) Health and social work activities. For presentation and simplification, the services rendered by government such as Public administration and defence, compulsory social security, Education, and Health and social work activities are combined.
